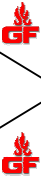

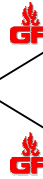

ROAD-RUNNER UPDATES

More great news from the Rosenbauer's Fremont aerial plant!

The **68' Road-Runner** TechDrive 2007 is due in Spokane for the Open House and will be on tour in our area for a couple of weeks. With the overwhelming response to the Roadrunner Rosenbauer has responded. There will be a slightly shorter version, and the work is completed with the alteration of our present **3**-section *Road-Runner* and now Rosenbauer is introducing a **51'** 2-section model.

This new model will feature a single pair of rear stabilizers (in place of the present 2-pairs) and also use a single lifting ram on the boom, in place of the present pair. The end result will be an apparatus with a **shorter** overall length, **lighter** weight, and **less** cost!
